

Chamberlain, Hrdlicka, White, Williams & Martin partner Richard N. Hubert's family trust has given \$5 million to the Hubert-Yeargan Center for Global Health at Duke University. The center's mission is to improve health practices through teaching and research in developing countries that include Tanzania, Sri Lanka and Thailand.

It was established in 2004 by a \$2.5 million gift from the Hubert Family Trust and a \$4 million gift from the Yeargan Charitable Foundation Trust. The Hubert Family Trust also has endowed a global health program at Emory University's Rollins School of Public Health and agricultural partnerships with charitable and faithbased organizations in North Korea and Haiti.
