



HOLWELL SHUSTER & GOLDBERG AND GEORGETOWN LAW REPRESENT FORMER FBI WHISTLEBLOWERS IN CALL FOR THE U.S. SUPREME COURT TO PROTECT CURRENT FBI EMPLOYEES WHO BLOW THE WHISTLE

New York—Holwell Shuster & Goldberg LLP and Georgetown Law’s Institute for Constitutional Advocacy and Protection (ICAP) filed a friend-of-the-court brief today on behalf of four former FBI whistleblowers, the National Whistleblower Center, and the Project On Government Oversight.
