The NBLSA is one of the largest student-run organizations in the United States, and aims to articulate and promote the needs and goals of Black law students to effectuate change in the legal community.

The annual event, which had a theme of "Celebrating Our Legacy, Advancing Our Mission," offered various social, professional, and educational opportunities to attendees.

During the convention, HSG partners Blair Kaminsky and Demian Ordway participated as judges in the organization's annual Frederick Douglass Moot Court Competition.
