New York—Chambers Associate, a leading law firm guide for law students, has recognized Holwell Shuster & Goldberg LLP as one of only 10 elite firms – the highest recognition given – across six different categories in its 2022 rankings. The annual rankings, which highlight the best performing law firms, are based on responses from associates and score firms on a combination of all topics that can affect an associate’s overall experience.

When asked about the firm’s overall structure, culture, and work, associates noted: “We’re only ten years old and that comes with a startup-like culture...We’re a relatively small group of incredible people, building the firm up into what we want it to be.” One interviewee also noted the ability to work on “top-notch litigation, but in a smaller, more intimate environment where new ideas are welcomed and heard.” Others added: “The firm puts an intentionally big focus on letting everyone be generalists,” and “I don’t think you could be siloed here if you tried!”

In its write-up on the firm’s commitment to pro bono and diversity, equity, and inclusion, Chambers notes that “HSG clocks more pro bono hours per attorney than over 96% of the firms we survey.”
